- Keep the nozzle close to the surface to avoid splashing
- Never point the nozzle at anyone –
- Keep children and pets away from the area while you're pressure washing–
- Never operate the washer around any sources of ignition, including fire, candles, and gas grills - Always turn off the power to the washer before you replace the nozzle or unclog the hose
